## My Craft for this Past Week

This past week I have bee experimenting with making sunflowers. I have made giant ones that attach to the wall, small ones that fit in a vase, and some decorative ones as well. I also tried different materials to find one that was easy to make and yet looked professional.. I am always striving for that professional look so that you can get those ooohs and aaahs when you create them for yourself.

So far I have found that the crepe-paper sunflower looks the best followed by the giant tissue paper model. The paper craft one was not bad and in fact, I am going to make a video on how to do all 3 so you can choose for yourself.

The biggest challenge for this project has been how to make the center portion of the flower. The tissue paper flower was the easiest with using tissue paper of another color, while the paper one is still a bit of a challenge as I want the flowers to look somewhat realistic. I actually bought a small round pumice stone in black for the center of one flower (I bought this at a dollar store). I can live with it but the search is still on.
