Another Learning Idea


I just discovered SliceForm! It is certainly something that I have yet to master, for sure. SliceForm allows you to create and make papercrafts where the pieces all fit into slots. (Like the inside of a box of glasses - you know, the dividers that fit into each other to make a partition). The application of SliceForm for making beautiful works of art is only bounded by your imagination. I found examples of very intricate "woven" patterns which were "slotted" together!
