Barbara also teaches new artists and has many long standing students!



After many, many, many experiments with making a pinwheel that spins, I finally found a method that works and is safe for kids. To me the most important part of the pinwheel is the handle and how the wings are attached. If it is too tight, nothing moves. If it is too loose, then it wobbles. I think I have the solution and it is simple - as long as you can handle a screw driver and a wood screw! I do hope you will give it a try - I have uploaded a few different size and shape templates for you to try. They are all located in my resource library.


Jennifer also has a list building course called <u>List Love</u> - I am working my way through this program as we speak. As the first program was so successful, I am truly excited about diving into this one as well.
