# **Other Activities Using my Cricut Maker**

Do you love experimenting with crafts? it is so much fun experimenting with all kinds of crafting projects and since there are new tools to use with my Cricut Maker, I thought I would give the engraving tool a try! Well, as usual, there were a ton of adjustments to make before I could get my project done the right way.

The first thing I did was design a plate for a door using Aluminum! I purchased the materials from Cricut and started on the process of making my etching. Since the aluminum had two sides, I started with the dull side to see if my design would work. It kind of did but I had a lot of design errors to fix. The adjustments were made the adjustments only to find the etching was not centered properly!

Ugh, back to the drawing board! More adjustments and finally, I have a design that is working! The article will soon be posted along with the video soon, but in the meantime, you can get the downloadable before the article is published.

Just go to my <u>resource library</u> and download the aluminum etching design file. I think you will love it as you can add your own text to the middle to make it completely yours.
