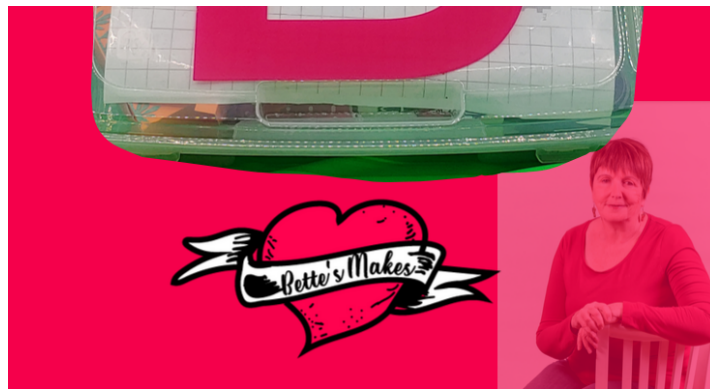

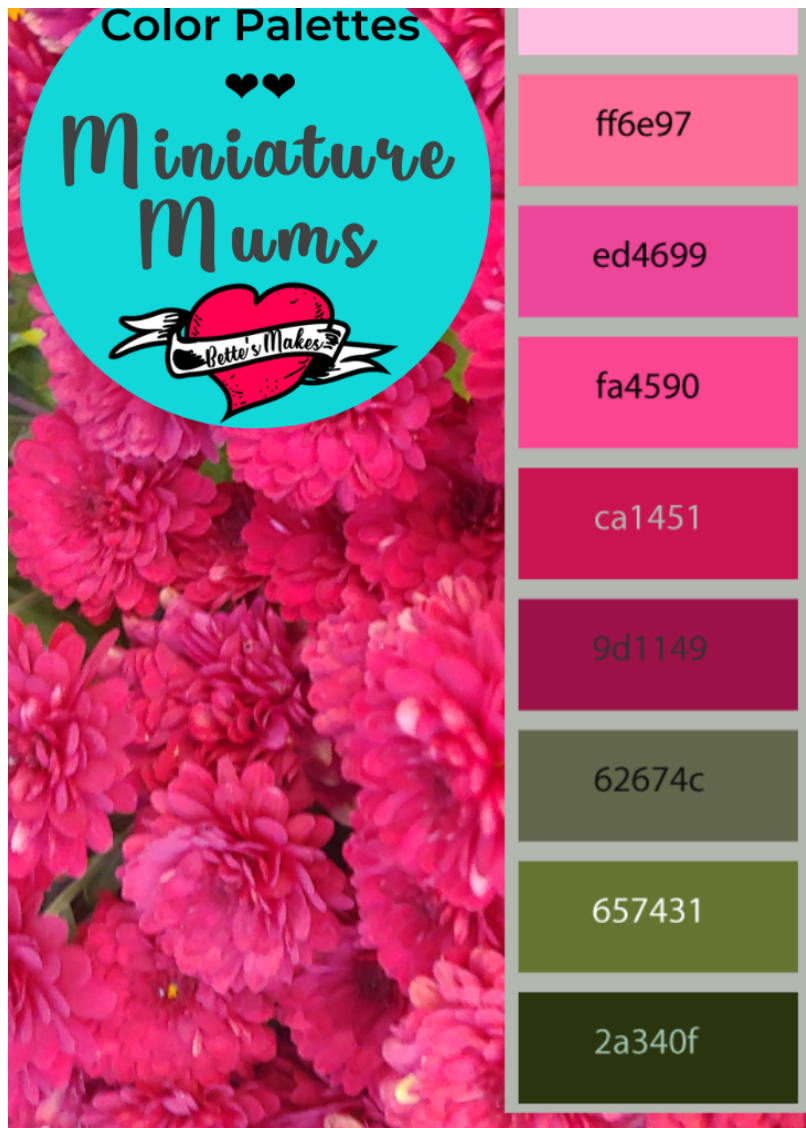
If you have not tried this one yet, you do not need a cutting machine, you need a good strong glue: [Chestnut Wreath](#)
