Etching and Engraving!

Etching (engraving) Aluminum using the engraving tool from Cricut (to be used with a Cricut Maker) was a great project. The biggest issue was making sure everything lined up and the engraving (etching) was placed properly. I purchased my aluminum sheet from Cricut.com but also found some at Michael's that were not quite the same size but would work with the engraving tool. The aluminum was a bit expensive as I tend to ruin the first one or two runs in any project! This one was no exception (someday I will learn to use paper and mockup the craft first). Still the results were fantastic! I included the template for the project in the resource library (the password is at the end of this newsletter, just in case you forgot it).
