
New Skill for Week 7 of the New Year!

I can see using this hand-made shapes in a variety of ways - perhaps as a Print and cut design for a nautical theme project.

To start, the ability to create such gorgeous see-through shapes and use them in my makes and surface designs is astounding. I love making things that are unusual and these certainly fit the



My Color Palette For This Week



I used one of my own photos for this week's palette and used it in Illustrator to make my own gradient effect with a random shape. I love using color theory for using the color palettes as you get a better understanding of what colors work well together.



This is a gradient I created using the color palette of The Grapes of Naramata - just an example of what you can do with color Palettes.
