
Be sure to include family members into your routine because there will always be time after the daily schedule to do even more (being stationed at home can be fun, even if it may be a long period of time).

How to Make An Easy Macrame Feather

I love this project as you can use macrame cord, yarn, string, or even ribbon to make these. The knots are very simple - there are actually only two knots (one knot that is done from the left and the same knot reversed from the right), so even kids can do this project without an issue. The feathers can be fat or thin, it all depends on how you want to trim them down. This tutorial is easy to follow. This is one of the first tutorial videos I put in place, so the format may not be the same as the other videos I have on the BettesMakes channel. Have fun and make several feathers. You can use them as dream catchers or group them into a wonderful mobile.
