
I am taking advantage of a T-shirt sale at Michael's to make something extra for

This Christmas, plaids are back in and I have some outlines that I am filling with plaid then doing a print and cut for more tree hangings. This is probably one of the easiest projects and the paid turned out perfectly! You can take any shape and fill it with the pattern (or you can use prepatterned plaid paper to do the same). For me, I designed the plaids and uploaded them as patterns into Design Space. From there it was easy to fill a shape (SVG) with the pattern. Once you fill with the pattern, it is automatically turned into a print and cut object.

I added the shapes to the <u>resource library</u> (asset #293) if you want to use them. I know you will love the shapes and as for the plaid digital papers - they are available from <u>Copious Crafts for \$2.99 - the pack comes with 10 different tartan designs</u>.



Last but not least, I finally bought a smaller <u>Easy Press</u> - I could not pass up the discount this time around and since I was an <u>access member</u>, I got a further discount plus I used a code to get free shipping (INSPIRE) - with this, I got a super deal. Always be on the look out for the deal through <u>Cricut</u> even if you do not buy right away you can put items in the "Save for Later"




