

Naturally, I had to order some and get out the EasyPress and create something new. Flocked means fuzzy so that the vinyl piece puffs out when applied to a surface. I decided that my jeans needed an uplift. Here is the design I used - a flower I made in Cricut Design Space (asset #303 in the <u>resource library</u>) which has 2 layers. I had never used <u>flocked iron-on</u> before but wow the results are amazing! I think I am hooked on it for adding that extra pizzazz to my makes.




