What I Made This Week!

I finally made another vinyl layered project using parchment paper! This is an amazing new way to minimize bubbles in your layers and a far more accurate way to line things up. Parchment paper can be used for any layering project and it is a real game-changer for sure! This is something you will want to try! I used a FREE Mandala Design from Design Bundles - you can get it here. This Mandala is 7 layers, which seem like quite a few. You can always cut that down to suit your own needs by eliminating a layer or two. I like to stick with 4 but this time I thought I would make the whole thing with vinyl.

A little tip with this one. I wanted to stick the mandala on a window for decoration but did not want it to be permanent. I used a non-permanent vinyl for the bottom layer and permanent for the remaining ones. I decided to use a sampler pack of <u>glitter vinyl</u> as it had enough colors to do the job. I found that I had to push through the cut twice to get my Maker to cut through the vinyl so did some of the layers in <u>permanent premium vinyl</u> instead. I am not 100% happy with the results but the parchment paper method of lining things up truly made a huge difference in making the layers work better for me.



Here is how mine turned out! I did a short video on the parchment paper process to show you how it is done. I think you are going to love this as you can use the same method for making layers with any material you wish, including iron-on.


