

This one is perfect for Mother's Day - which is not too far off in the future! You can also use it for making other designs for T-shirts or as an infusible ink project.



More FREE Stuff from Design Bundles - <u>Luckiest Clover in the</u> <u>Patch</u>

This freebie is a sublimation design that can be used for t0shirts, mugs, tumblers, tote bags, etc. If you are not sure what sublimation is - "Sublimation, or dye sublimation printing, is a process where you use a special printer, special inks, and special paper to create a design to put on a variety of blank products. You then use a heat press to transfer the design onto a specially coated product blank." In other words, you can print and cut these and use the EasyPress to iron-on a t-shirt.


