### Another Thing to Buy!

Every time I turn around, there is a new product to buy, a new process that potentially works better, a new update to the type of material you are using, and the list goes on! We do have to move forward and try new things, there is no doubt about it and I am first on the

bandwagon to try stuff out. The new Cricut Mug Press is no exception! Mine finally arrived this week and I have been working on designs that will work with it.

**BTW** you can get my current designs for these mugs as my freebie this week. So make sure you get yours.

Did you know that **Cricut was going to limit** how many personal items you could upload to Design Space - this announcement really caused a big uproar in the Cricut community. So much so, that they rescinded the limits for users until December 31 of this year. People who have purchased a new Cricut this year may not have anything to worry about and access members will continue they way they are operating into the future. As a precaution, it may be wise to join the Access program to make sure you can upload all you want! I know budgets get in the way and so giving up one coffee shop visit to pay for this is so worth it, especially when Circut may start charging for personal uploads.

As a reminder, I will be opening the doors to **my Cricut Confidence course again at the end of March** and adding some more live sessions for those who want to get on board early. The price has gone up this year but if you purchased the Ultimate Cricut Toolkit, you will get a \$50 discount. Don't yet have a toolkit? You can get yours here. #### What is happening this week?

Design Space has been updated once again and added a really interesting feature called offset! It used to be that making stickers with a background required you to use programs such as Illustrator to get the sizing just right. Now it is a lot simpler. This is a real game changer, especially when you are doing stickers or even adding embellishments to your designs. This is one I did and used a yellow background as the offset so you can see it.



### **Try This New Project!**

There is really not enough time to play around with all the different ways you can now use your Cricut and Design Space. This week I tried another new idea using some of my left over materials. Basically I wanted to do some infusible ink things on a T-Shirt - I actually iron-on the overall design then did some coloring right on the t-shirt to bring out the colors. Then added some more heat to make sure it really infused into the material. I will be doing a video on this later - but here is an advanced look a the results:





### My Make of the Week - How to Make Foiled Easter Eggs

If you have an Air 2 or a Maker, then this will be a project you can do quite easily! These eggs are perfect for adding to cards, using for table settings, you can use them anywhere you wish. I know you are going to love these!

This is a great place to start and then go to the playlists and choose Start Here - you are going to love it! You do NOT need to be an ACCESS MEMBER to use this,




### Cricut Bulk Mat Sale
