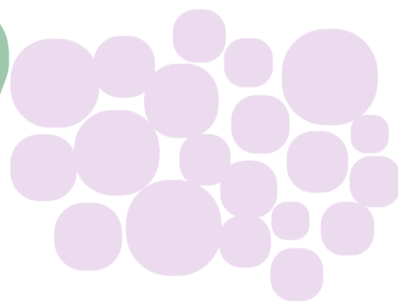
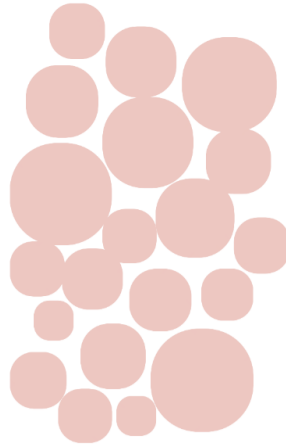
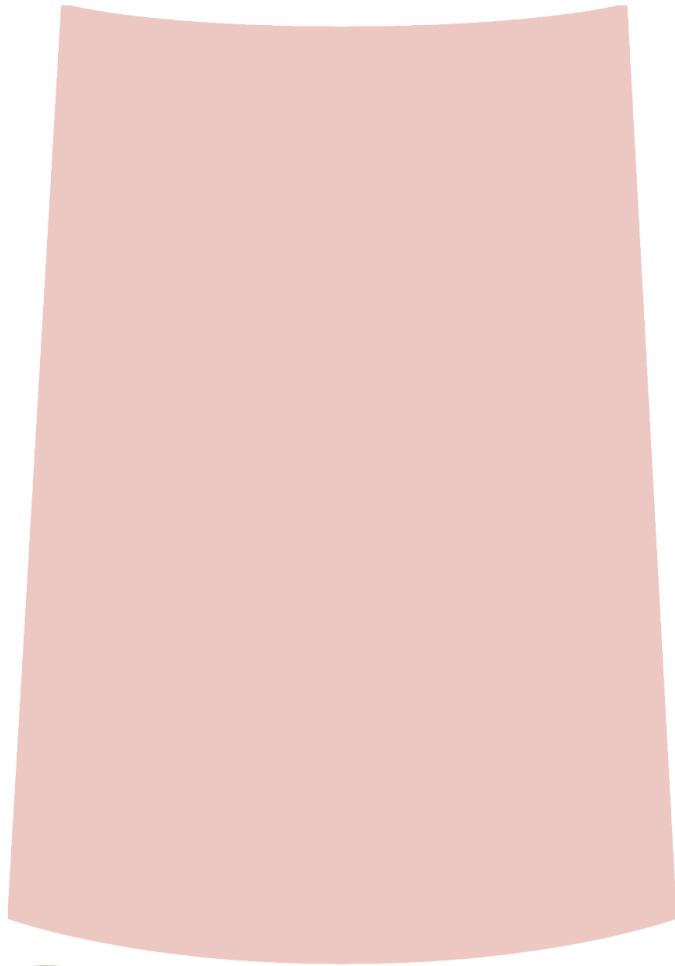
Print and Cut the images on the next few pages. You may enlarge them as needed to create the 3D Mushroom and Butterfly Diorama as pictured on the front page.

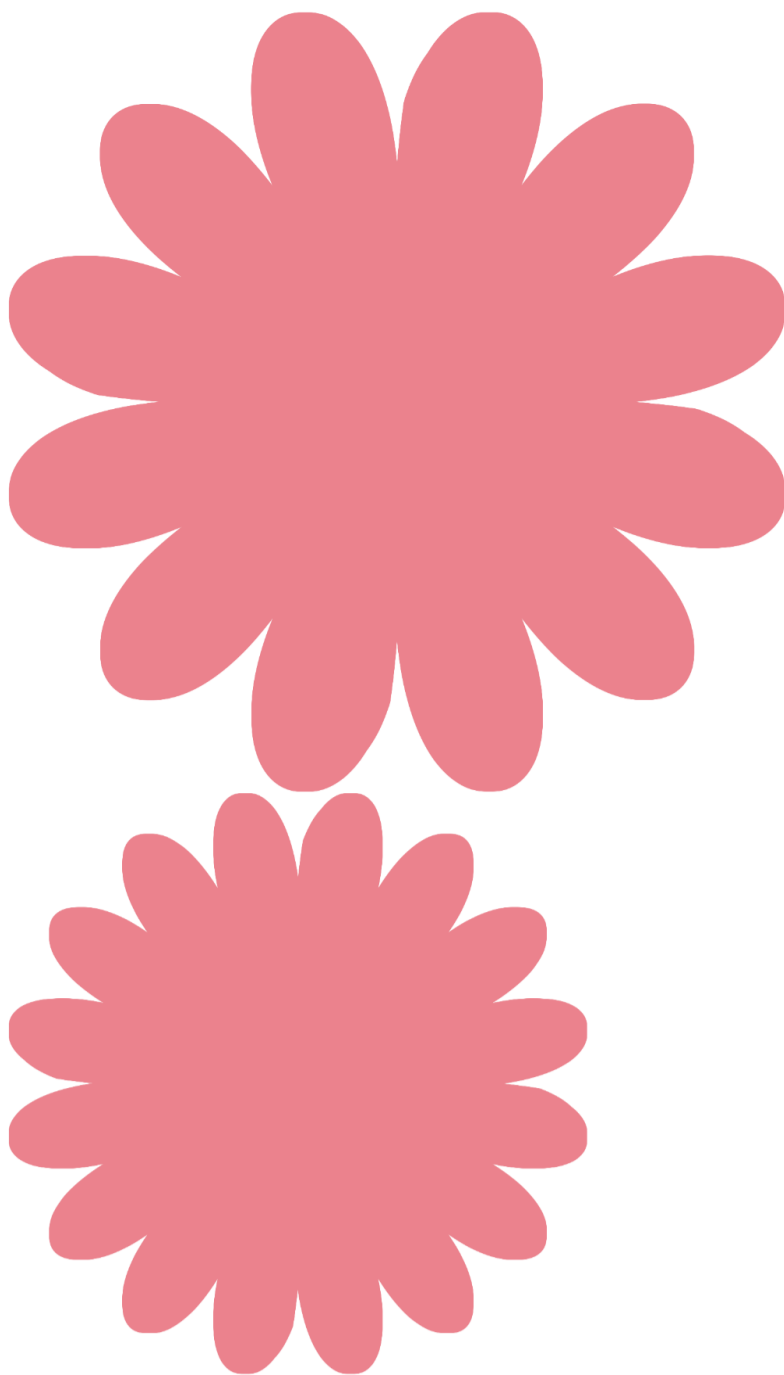
You may use a shoebox or other enclosure to make your project stand out. You can also find this project in Design Space by Cricut.

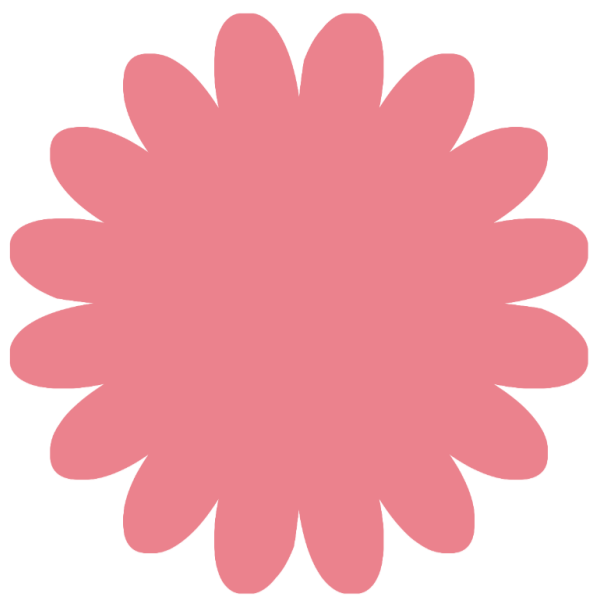












Directions

- Cut out all of the pieces on these pages - you may want to enlarge them to make a bigger diorama.
- Assemble the Butterflies first. Glue the center of the pattern cut butterfly to the same sized solid butterfly then when the glue is dry, fold the cut out pattern butterfly so that it looks like it is flying - see the front page for an example.
- Assemble the mushrooms by taking the large stem pieces and glueing the edges together lengthwise. Make sure the rings with the petals can fit around the stems



- Assemble the mushroom caps and glue them to the top of the mushroom stems



- glue the large circles around the bottoms of the mushroom so it is able to stand then glue everything to a mat or bottom of the shoe box.
- Assemble the grass pieces around the bottom and glue in place.
- Make any flowers you wish to fit in with the scene
- Now, attach the butterflies into the diorama
